2024-25 Early Years Funding - changes

- Two new entitlements in 2024-25 financial year:-
 - 15 hours for working parents of 2 year olds from April 2024
 - o 15 hours for working parents of under 2s from September 2024

 SEN Inclusion Fund (SENIF), Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) and Disability Access Fund (DAF) will be extended to all age ranges





Funding Principles within Bolton

- Passport as much funding to providers through the hourly rates as possible:-
 - Centrally retained funding not increased since 2017-18
- Support SEN through a SENIF fund
- Model new entitlements similar to the existing rates, eg application of a deprivation supplement





Centrally Retained Expenditure

- Utilised by the Local Authority to contribute to the administration of the entitlements and to contribute to a range of support to providers
- Current legislation is to passport a minimum 95% of funding to providers
- Increasing to 97% in the future to reflect a wider funding pot, no date has been published
- Centrally retained value increasing in Bolton due to:-
 - Increased workload from increased provision
 - Budget pressures due to no inflation over the years

The proposed Central Expenditure is £1,147,800 The table below shows the comparison to 2023-24: -

SEN Inclusion Fund (SENIF)

- Included in pass through rate as funding goes to providers
- Current SENIF facing demand pressures
- Fund extending to all age groups from 9 mth to 4 years
- The proposed SENIF fund for 2024-25 is £1,000,000.

Timeline

- EY Sub-group meeting 10th January 2024, beginning of the consultation period.
- Schools Forum 19th January 2024.
- Consultation ends on the 31st January 2024.
- Approval of Funding Executive Cabinet Member for Childrens Services meeting February 2024.





Other Issues

Payment Dates

- Due to the increase in government funding, we are proposing to bring the payment dates 1 week forward.
- 3 & 4 Year Olds 2nd Thursday of the month.
- 2 Year Olds 3rd Thursday of the month.
- The portal headcount dates are going to be brought forward slightly to account for this change.
- If Providers do not submit the first initial submission No payment will be made.
- If an additional payment is required outside of the above dates, a charge will be applied.





Other Issues

Parent Declaration Form

- Parent Declaration form to be reviewed.
- Increase in shared funding queries.
- In the provider/parent contract the notice period needs to be highlighted to parents on the point of sign up - if the notice period is not adhered to the nursery will invoice parents for the loss in funding.
- Reminder to: Add leave date (Last date of attendance) & Adjust the weeks & hours to account for the leaver.
- This is to avoid overpayment and repayment plans needed.
- EY Finance continue to send Shared Funding reports within the term, please can these be actioned on the headcount to avoid overpayments being made OR email <u>earlyyearsfinance@bolton.gov.uk</u> if you believe your headcount is correct.
- If corrections are not actioned on the portal, EY Finance will adjust accordingly.





Other Issues

- Provider Agreement we are working with our legal team to re write these
 and once they are ready to share we will get these out to all providers,
 This will set out the legal responsibilities regarding the payment of funding
 ensuring we all adhere to the Statutory guidance
- Operational Guidance There are changes one to note;
- Local processes. We will be updating the protocol and ensuring systems are ready and making changes to Headcount and sufficiency reporting in line with the Funding expansions.
