Key considerations - Flu

- Influenza levels extremely low globally in 2020 to 2021as a result of nonpharmaceutical interventions in place for COVID-19
- A lower level of population immunity against influenza expected in 2021-22
- First winter where seasonal flu and COVID-19 viruses will co-circulate, with potential to add substantially to inter pressures and seasonal flu predicted to be earlier
- Social mixing and contact returning to pre-pandemic norms
- Modelling suggests the 21-22 flu season in the UK could be up to 50% higher than typically seen and may begin earlier than usual
- Flu vaccination a priority to reduce morbidity, mortality and hospitalisations this Winter across the wider population, when the NHS and social care may also be managing winter outbreaks of COVID-19.

Early Years:

- •All council run children's centres
- •Early Years group providers and all out of school providers.
- Childminders
